Without this shining example of our ability, as nations to work together for freedom and a peaceful, democratic future, would President Harry Truman and his Secretary of State, Gen. George Marshall, have been able to appeal to the magnanimity of the United States Congress to enact the **Marshall Plan** on June 3rd 1948, only one-and-a-half years after the adoption of the Hessen Constitution? Germany and Western Europe would recover with the Marshall Plan, which in turn would serve as the foundation of today's **European Union (EU).** Each event hinged on the success of the
